

Your efforts and hard work over the years have finally made the dream of preserving the north golf course as urban open space a reality. In honor of this occasion, Bernalillo County and UNM are hosting events on Friday, June 13th and Saturday, June 14th, that I hope you will be able to attend.

On Friday there will be the official Ribbon Cutting at 2:30pm at the North Course, 2201 Tucker Ave. NE. This event will include brief remarks by Board Of Regents President Jack Fortner, UNM President Bob Frank, North Campus Neighborhood Association UNM Liaison Tim Davis and a Putting Ceremony.

On Saturday, June 14th, a Fun Run begins at the North Course at 9:00am. This free family event is envisioned as a community celebration and residents from across Bernalillo County are invited to help celebrate Bernalillo County's newest Open Space property.

Bernalillo County has overseen \$1.5 million in upgrades to the running trail, trees, landscaping and irrigation system at the UNM North Golf Course this year. The area is now protected as an Urban Open Space under a special agreement between Bernalillo County and the University of New Mexico. In addition to these improvements, the North Campus Neighborhood Association and the UNM Foundation are raising money to plant additional trees on the 79-acre open space.

I look forward to seeing you at these events at the UNM North Golf Course on Friday, June 13th and on Saturday, June 14th, and know that I can count on you to make them a success. In fact, I would like the Fun Run to become a yearly event which honors community involvement
